Nomination for the 2022 Franklin-Lavoisier Prize

The Franklin-Lavoisier Prize was established in 2007 by the Fondation de la Maison de la Chimie and the Science History Institute to recognize individuals in both France and the United States for their work with our shared modern and historical scientific heritage. The prize includes a plaque detailing the winner's achievement as well as a monetary prize of €15.000.

The Franklin-Lavoisier Prize is awarded to someone who has made extraordinarily significant contributions to one of these three areas:

- 1. The preservation and highlighting of any aspect of our common scientific or industrial heritage in the fields of chemistry and its related applications.
- 2. The promotion of the history of the chemical and molecular sciences and industries.
- 3. The fostering of closer Franco-American ties and the promotion of significant activities, in the chemical sciences or industries.
